P 3.3 ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT POLICY

Australian Steel Mill Services Pty

Environmental Policy Statement

Australian Steel Mill Services Pty (ASMS) is a joint venture between Cement Australia Group and Edw C Levy Co (USA) formed in 1989 to service the slag handling contract at BlueScope Steel, Port Kembla NSW. The contract involves collecting and treating approximately 2 million tonnes of slag material per year from BlueScope Steel blast furnaces and steel making processes. The Company is responsible for processing and marketing the slag for use as quality products in the building and civil construction industries.

It is the policy of ASMS to conduct its operations in an environmentally responsible manner and in conformity with appropriate legal and community standards.

ASMS's approach to environmental management seeks continual improvement in performance by taking account of evolving scientific knowledge and community expectations.

To implement this policy, we will:

- Work closely with BlueScope Steel Port Kembla, State and Federal Governments and relevant Statutory Authorities and with the Community, to develop practices which promote avoidance, recycling, re-use and control to minimise the impact of our activities on the environment.
- Set targets, develop, implement and maintain management standards and systems, and comply with relevant industry standards, legal and other requirements.
- Provide appropriate training for all employees on environmental matters relevant to their workplace.
- Have an ongoing programme of communication on environmental matters with all employees, sub-contractors and with the community and ensure all employees and suppliers of goods and services are informed about this policy and are aware of their environmental responsibilities in relation to ASMS business.
- Ensure a management system is in place to identify, control and monitor environmental risks arising from operations.
- Ensure all environmental incidents are acted upon to prevent or minimise impact on the environment. Environment Incident Reports are to be completed by the Supervisor, Co-ordinator or responsible Officer and forwarded to the ASMS Manager.
- Ensure all Environmental Incident Reports related to Licence condition are faxed to BlueScope Steel Environment Department as soon as possible after receipt from ASMS personnel.
- Regularly monitor and report on our progress.
